Aroma	Strong	Eucalyptus, menthol, mint, <i>tea tree oil</i> , wood, lime,
Texture		Smooth, drying, some sediment,
Flavour	Strong	Eucalypt/gum, menthol, mint, <i>teatree</i> , lemon, medicinal,
Aftertaste		Lingering, bitter, drying, <i>astringent</i> , some oiliness,
