Steps
<p>[1] Pre-engagement</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify potential locations and partner communities • Determine who has relevant authority needed for permissions for research
<p>[2] Pre-research & Pre-collection</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Send information on ARC Training Centre to community, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - IP and ABS engagement policy - Authorship policy - Data collection policy • Formal obligations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Letter of support from communities for research - UQ Ethics Approval - Permits from relevant government authorities/communities - Project Agreement between UQ and Community (including IP and ABS)
<p>[3] During research</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Communication of interim research results • Discuss plans for communication of research outputs (publication, seminars, reports etc)
<p>[4] After-research</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Communicate final research results with communities • Discuss future possible collaborations
